

Dispute Request

We hereby request to establish a DISPUTE entry for the domain

...

for the benefit of

...

(applicant of DISPUTE). In the event that I/we am/are not the DISPUTE applicant myself/ourselves, I/we assure that I/we have been authorized by the DISPUTE applicant and that I/we am/are aware that DENIC may request a corresponding authorization to be submitted as a prerequisite for further processing.

According to my/our understanding the DISUPUTE applicant is entitled to the domain (e.g. due to a trademark or name). **Attached please find documents that prove this entitlement.**

I/we assure that the DISPUTE applicant is involved in a legal dispute or about to start such dispute with the holder of the domain for the above reason in order to achieve that the domain is deleted or transferred.

I/We will notify DENIC without delay as soon as that dispute is settled so that the DISPUTE entry can be removed. I/We am/are aware that the DISPUTE entry is limited to the duration of one year and that it will then expire without any further notice, unless an application for prolongation is submitted in due time (i.e. at least four weeks prior to expiration). I/We am/are also aware that DENIC has the right to cancel the DISPUTE entry early if facts become known that render continuation of the DISPUTE entry baseless.

Exemption from liability: Regardless of any other claims or rights going beyond that scope, I/we and/or the DISPUTE applicant unconditionally and completely indemnify DENIC and the DENIC member who administers the domain from any claims of third parties, including the costs of possibly incurred appropriate legal defence, that may be raised in connection with the DISPUTE entry.

In the event that the DISPUTE applicant becomes the holder of the domain due to the deletion of that domain, there will be a domain contract (without prejudice to the possibility of having the domain administered by a provider) between DENIC and the DISPUTE applicant, and the DENIC Domain Guidelines and Domain Terms and Conditions will apply (see <http://www.denic.de/de/domainrichtlinien.html> and <http://www.denic.de/de/domainbedingungen.html>).
